

- **Special Rapporteur on Adequate Housing**

Special Rapporteur on Adequate Housing, Raquel Rolnik presented her last thematic report, her reports from missions to Croatia and Kazakhstan, her preliminary note on her mission to the World Bank Group and her report including the communications received from governments in relation with alleged violations of the right to adequate housing. She believed that her main contribution to the mandate during the past three years had been to support States and other stakeholders in bridging the gap between the international human rights legal framework on housing and territorial polices. In this context, Mrs. Rolnik had tried on one hand to produce materials “translating” the right to adequate housing in international legal framework into common citizens and policy makers’ language.

H.E. Ms. Iruthisham Adam participated in the dialogue with the Special Rapporteur and said that the Maldives concurred with many of the findings contained in the report, in particular with the right to housing in the context of natural disasters, including those attributed to climate change.
