Thank you, Mr. President,

The Maldives warmly welcomes the distinguished delegation of Tunisia to this session.

We commend Tunisia for accepting majority of the recommendations received during its 4th cycle of the Universal Periodic Review held on 08 November 2022.

My delegation notes with appreciation that Tunisia has accepted the recommendation by the Maldives to improve the quality of education by providing vocational training opportunities for students, updating teaching materials and supporting the continuous learning of teachers and the recommendation to strengthen the legal and institutional system for environmental protection, in particular with respect to biodiversity and climate change.

The Maldives recommends the adoption of the 4th Cycle UPR report of Tunisia by consensus and wishes the Government of Tunisia every success in implementation of the accepted recommendations.
